- A wide range of European wool products.

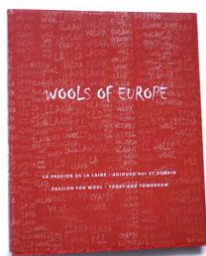
The exhibition "Wools of Europe" is based in Biella, in Italy, from September 2010.
